
## Fonterra Milk for Schools pilot programme announced

Our friends from some well-known brands came on board, supporting us with their expert services from supplying fridges, bins and packaging to transport and distribution.



It was official – Fonterra Milk for Schools was now nationwide. Starting at the very bottom of the South Island in Invercargill, we rolled out region by region.

At signed-up schools in the south, milk packs arrived and were stacked in fridges, getting nice and cool ready for drinking.
