Ashburton District Council decides not to sell fresh water rights

'Ashburton District Council [cancels] the sale of water rights to bottled water company NZ Pure Blue.' The initial decision to sell a resource consent that would have enabled the owner to extract up to 45 litres of water per second from the town's aquifer through to 2046 begins a public discussion on fresh water ownership, with the government reiterating its view that no one owns fresh water. Ministry for Vulnerable Children (Oranga Tamariki) announced

This Ministry replaces the Child, Youth and Family government agency. The English name comes under criticism for its use of the word 'vulnerable', with many preferring the broader Māori name. Oranga Tamariki translates to child wellbeing and suggests that all of society is responsible for the wellbeing of New Zealand's children. [t61–2016]
