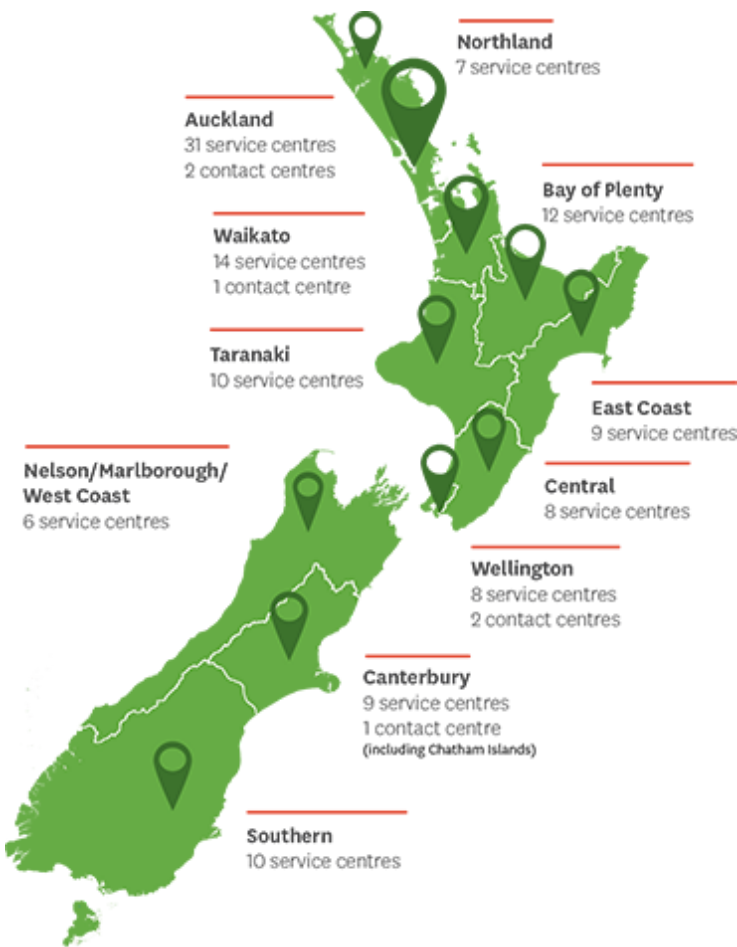


## Our locations

People can access our services, including benefits, superannuation and student assistance, at **130 site offices and contact centres** [1].(#1b) throughout New Zealand. We also have **11 Regional Offices, 24 centralised service offices**, and our National Office in Wellington. In another **40 smaller communities** our service locations are part of local **Heartland Services** (<http://www.heartlandservices.govt.nz/>).[2].(#2b), where people can access the services of several different government agencies in one place.
