Aotearoa New Zealand hosts CPTPP in 202

Aotearoa New Zealand is Chair of the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership in 2023.

The centrepiece of New Zealand's hosting year will be the 7th Commission Meeting of the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP) which will be held from 15–16 July in Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland. We look forward to warmly welcoming Trade Ministers and representatives attending this meeting.

CPTPP spans 11 economies - Australia, Brunei Darussalam, Canada, Chile, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, New Zealand, Peru, Singapore, and Viet Nam - which represent \$17.3 trillion of global trade.

The Commission Meeting will be an opportunity to work with the CPTPP membership to further regional economic integration and promote inclusive and sustainable trade that delivers economic opportunity, prosperity and benefits for all our people

CPTPP members will also welcome the United Kingdom as the newest member of the Agreement at a signing ceremony held during the Commission Meeting.

In addition to highlighting the importance of inclusive and sustainable trade, Aotearoa New Zealand will use its host year to promote indigenous trade and economic empowerment, working with members to ensure that the Agreement remains relevant to the trade and investment issues we collectively face, and developing practical initiatives that deliver gains for exporters.
