Giles, Rex, 1929-2006

Pioneered the development and legislation concerning deer farming and the game industry in New Zealand. He was granted the first licence issued in New Zealand authorising the farming of deer on the 13th of March 1970. His Farm was located at Maroa, Taupo, and was called "Forest park" (previously Rahana Station). His company, Consolidated Traders Limited, included a warehouse for skins at Evans Bay, Wellington, meat packing plants at Rotorua and Rongatea, base buildings for deer recovery at Fox Glacier, hanger and maintainance base for aircraft at Greymouth, and a company involved in mineral exploration and mining.
