Murray, G F, 1809-1866

Born St John's, Newfoundland 21 June 1809, died 1866. Served in Taranaki (1 Mar-14 Sep 1860) with the 65th Regiment. Lieutenant Colonel commanding a garrison in New Plymouth in 1860. Highest rank in New Zealand Brevet Lieut. Colonel (Major - Army rank). His widow died in Sheerness, England, on 16 Nov 1871 (Wanganui herald, 3 Feb 1872, p 2).
