Maori political party formed in 1979 by Matiu Rata, a member of the Labour Party. Mana Motuhake stood candidates in the 1981, 1984, 1987 and 1990 elections, but was unsuccessful on each occasion. In 1991 the party agreed to join forces with three other political parties (New Labour, Greens, and the Democratic Party) to form a single group, known as the Alliance. This decision was controversial, as a number of prominent figures in Mana Motuhake believed that by joining the party with non-Maori parties, even sympathetic ones, the party would no longer be free to speak up for Maori. Those who supported the continuation of an independent Maori party found the new Mana Maori party, led by Eva Rickard. The party was deregistered in 2005.
